## Volunteers Needed for Paid Research Study

We are conducting a research study about HIV risk and prevention among women who are currently pregnant, or have recently been pregnant. The purpose of this study is to help researchers learn more about the types of barriers that make it difficult for pregnant women to protect themselves from HIV after and during involvement with the criminal justice system.

### You May Qualify If You:

- Are between the ages of 18-45
- Can complete an interview in English
- Live in Miami-Dade County
- Have ever been arrested, incarcerated, and or under community supervision (probation/parole)
- Currently pregnant (regardless of pregnancy intentions) OR have been pregnant in the past two years (regardless of pregnancy outcome)
- Have struggled with the use of opioids or stimulants

### Participation Involves:

- Completing a brief study screener over the phone
- Completing a 60-90-minute interview in person or via Zoom
- Complete a brief (10 minute) survey
